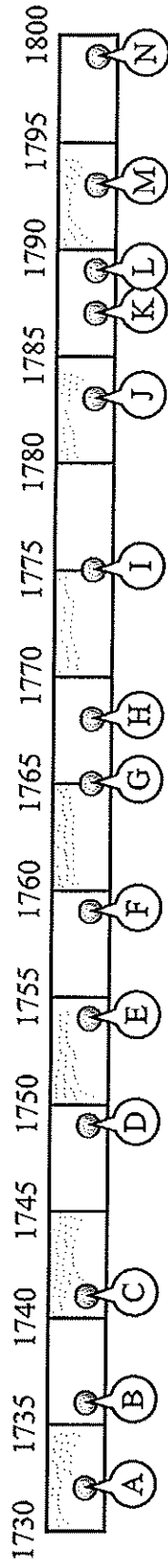

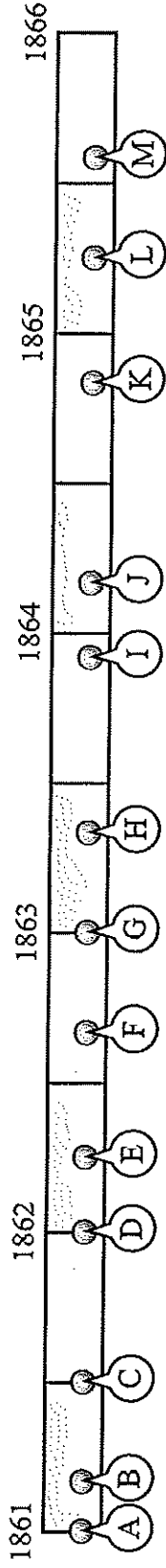

The American Civil War

- 2) General Stonewall Jackson (confederate) is mortally wounded by one of his men during a battle. (May 1863)
- 3) Confederate (the south) troops fire on Fort Sumter. The first hostilities of the civil war. (Jul. 1861)
- 4) The south secedes. (Jan. 1861)
- 5) Lincoln is sworn in as president. (Mar. 1861)
- 6) Abraham Lincoln is re-elected as president of the United States. (Nov. 1864)
- 7) The battle of Antietam. (Sep. 1862)
- 8) Ulysses S. Grant is given control of all union (the north) troops. (Mar. 1864)
- 9) Emancipation Proclamation is issued, eventually freeing all slaves. (Jan. 1863)
- 10) General Lee surrenders, effectively ending the civil war. (Apr. 1865)

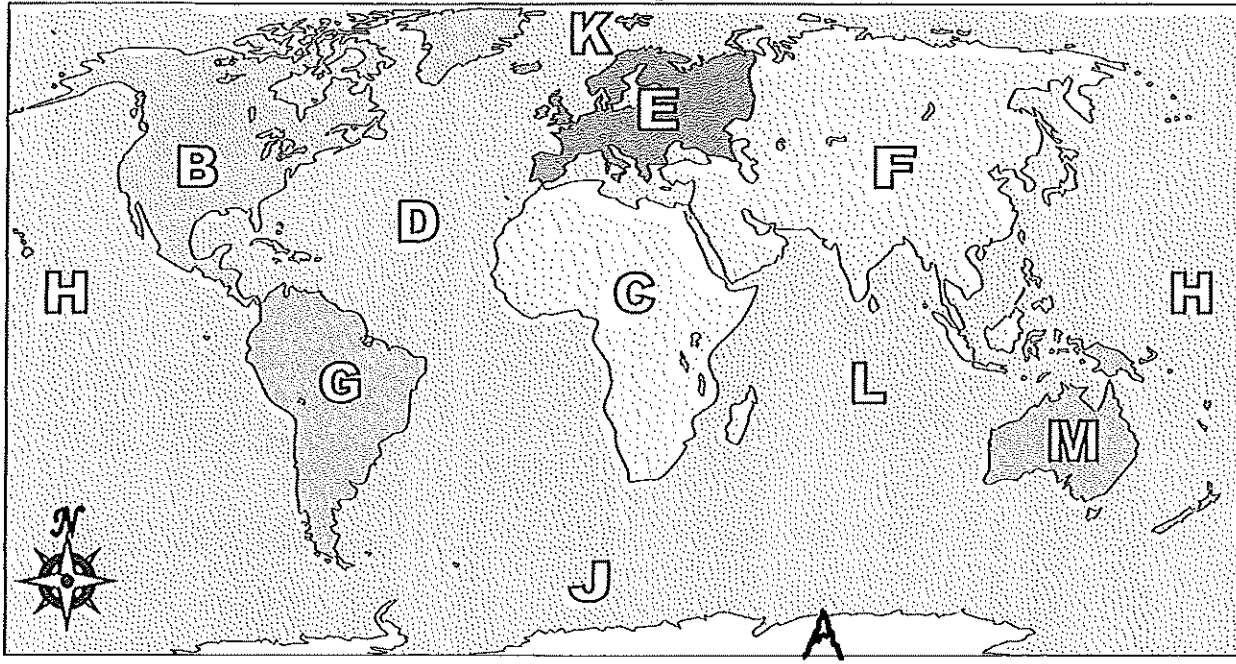
